Students can participate anytime their school offers the ASVAB CEP and they can use the career planning tools for up to two years.

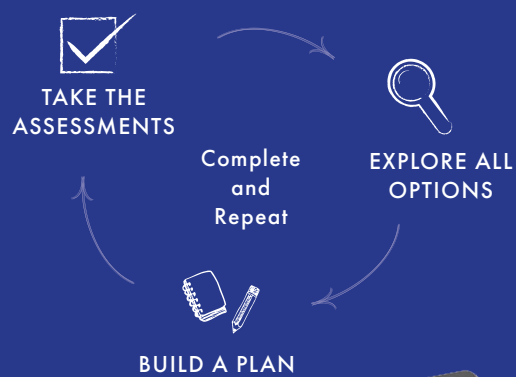


The ASVAB CEP includes a validated aptitude test and interest assessment. The results are used to guide career exploration using our planning tools.

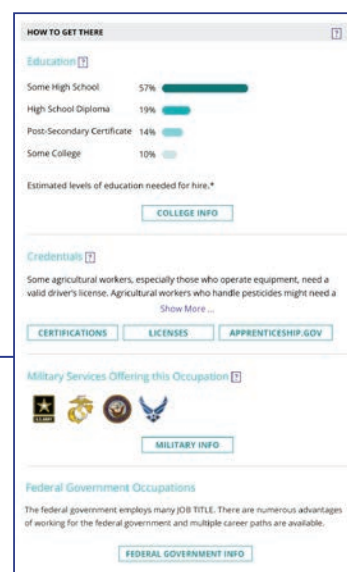

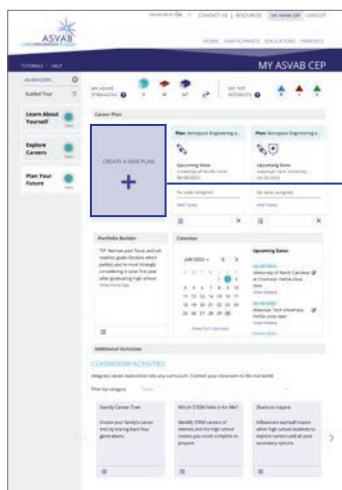
